

What's on the Horizon for Taxation

The global tax landscape is changing with potentially dramatic impacts for airlines. The OECD and the UN are advancing proposals for major revisions to tax frameworks that would significantly complicate airline taxation by necessitating filing in all jurisdictions in which they operate—in contravention of ICAO rules and bilateral agreements. Climate mitigation and adaptation initiatives see aviation taxes as a potential novel financing source. And cash strapped treasuries are not sparing airlines in their hunt for more revenues.






